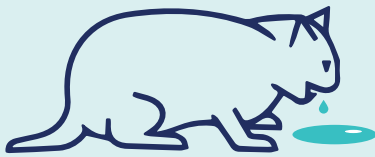




Signs Your Pet Ingested or Inhaled a Poisonous or Toxic Substance

LETHARGY OR WEAKNESS



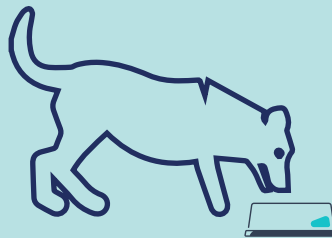
RAPID BREATHING OR SHORTNESS OF BREATH



PALE GUMS OR EXCESSIVE SALIVATION

INHALED POISONS

Carbon monoxide, smoke and chemical fumes are all forms of inhaled poisons. Exposure can result in disorientation or unconsciousness, with or without coughing.
